

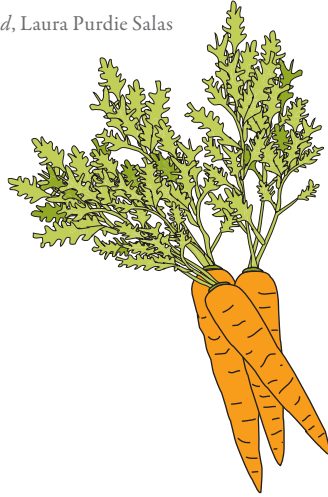
Acrostic POEMS
