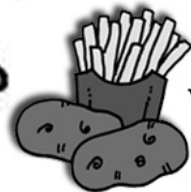
Andy's parents were not too worried because the same thing had happened to Andy's cousin, Stanley, a few years before. Stanley became so famous that a book has been written about him.
