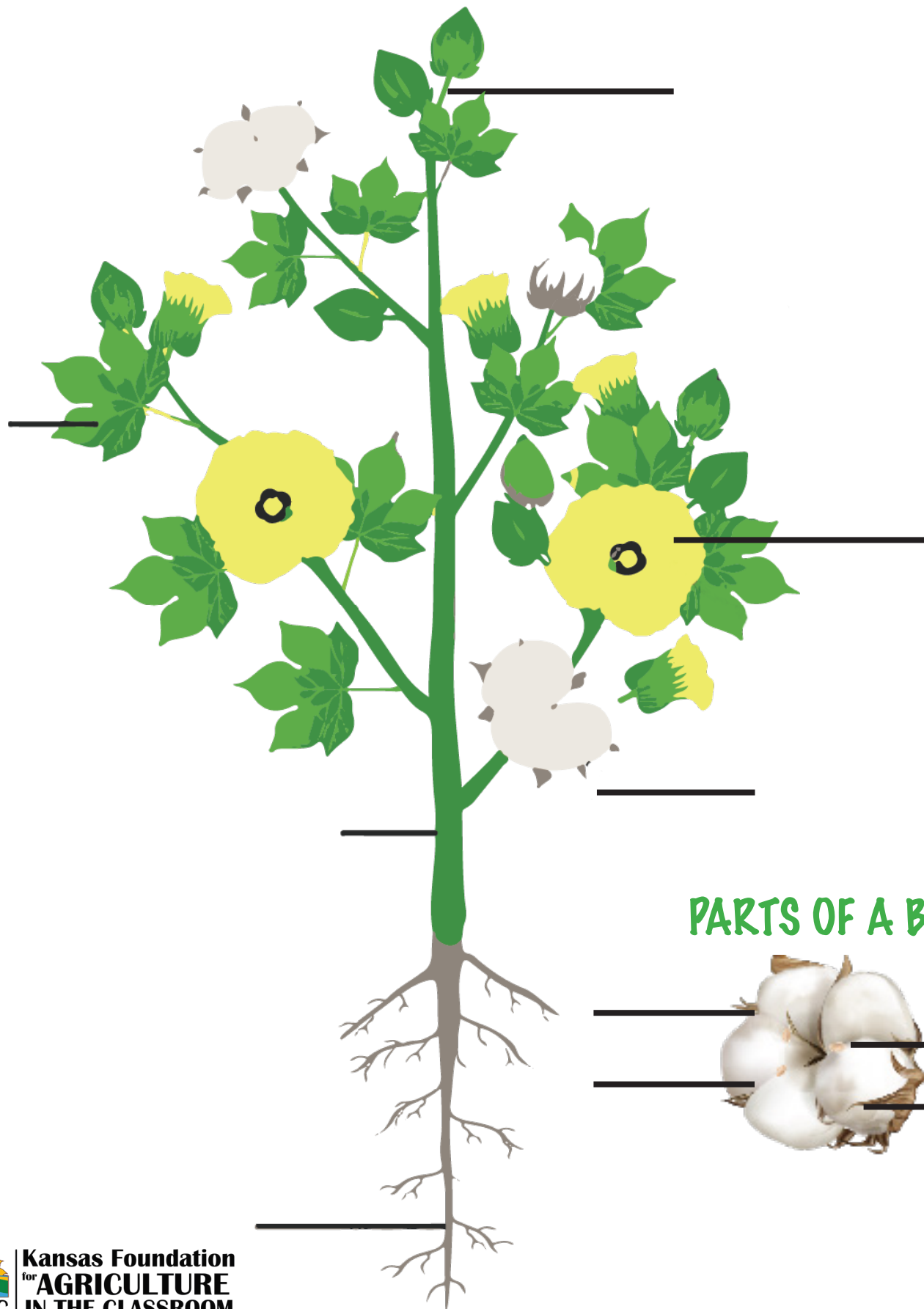

the fruit of the cotton plant, and it protects the cotton seeds and helps disperse them.

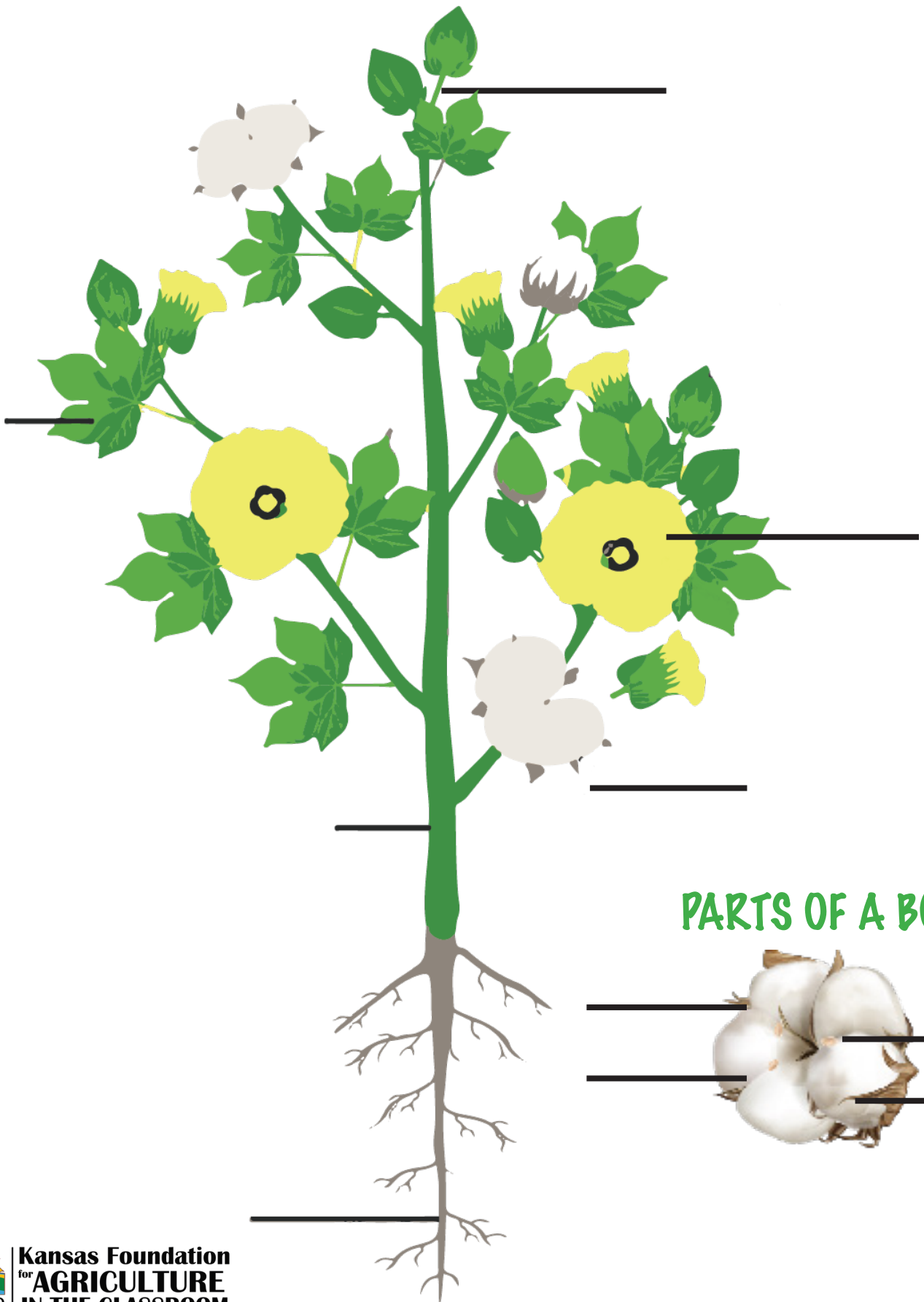
protects the cotton seeds and helps disperse them.

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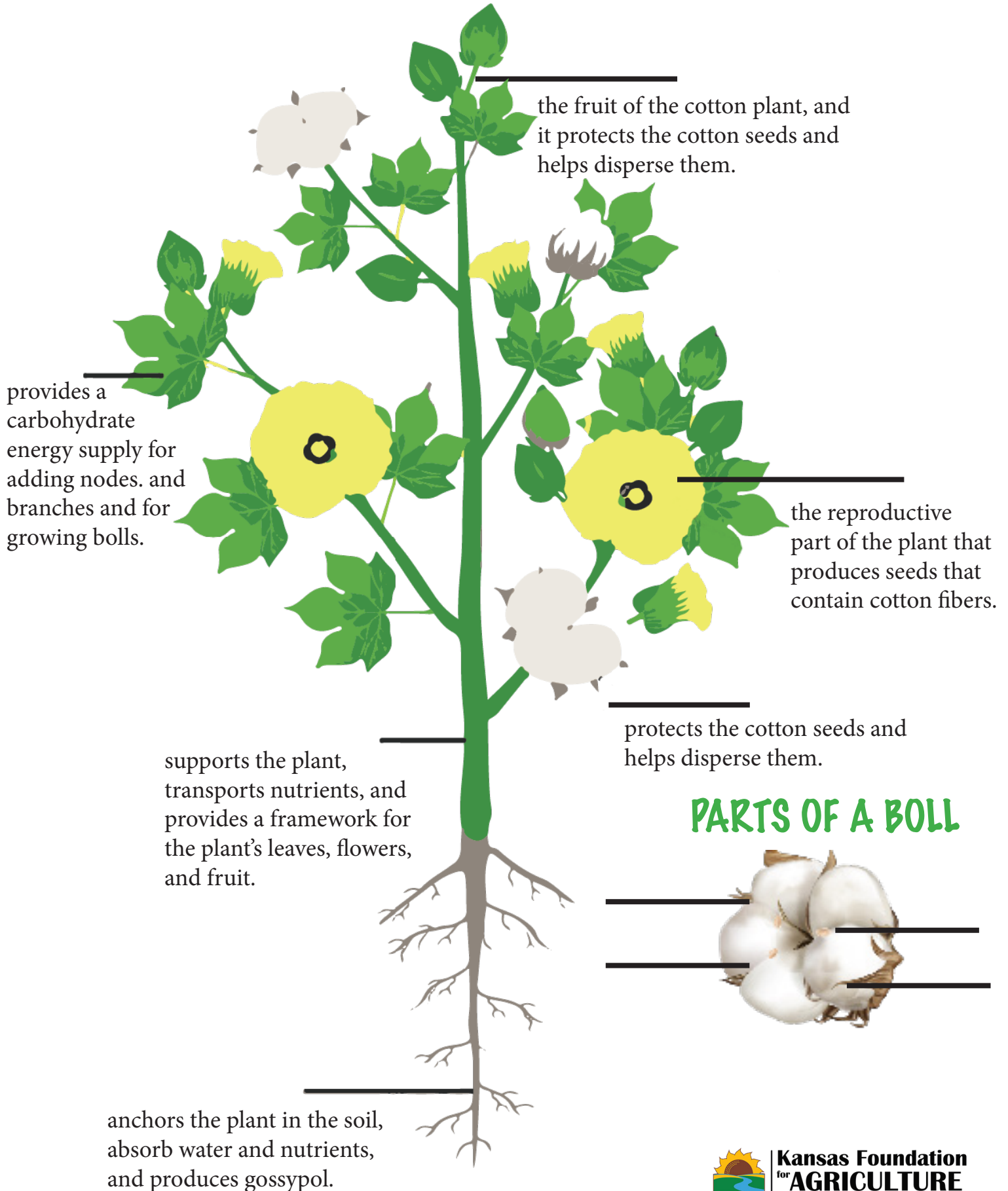
