I am shaped like a bell.



I often grow on thorny bushes.




Tomato

Some people eat the leafy greens separately.




Onion

I can bring tears to your eyes.






Potato

me "spud." I am a very popular vegetable.


I can be mashed, baked, boiled, grilled and fried.

sweet on the inside. I am orange and




Pumpkin

I am sweet.




Yellow Summer Squash
