LOCATION: Where is it?

Absolute Location: A precise point on Earth. Latitude

& longitude or a street address

- •Paris France is 48° N Latitude and 2° E Longitude.
- •The White House is located at 1600 Pennsylvania Ave.

Relative Location: Described by landmarks, time, direction or distance. From one place to another.

•Go 1 mile west on main street and turn left for 1 block.



PLACE: All places have both human and physical characteristics

Human Characteristics

language, customs, beliefs, population, etc...

Physical Characteristics

Landforms, climate, vegetation, wildlife, soil, etc...

REGION

Regions are areas with similar characteristics.

•Physical characteristics:

Climate, landforms, etc...



Human characteristics:

Religion, economic activity, ethnicity, language, etc..
