



Bee Pollination Activity

Have a pollination relay and learn how bees transfer pollen from one flower to another

Directions

1. Read the book and discuss the role of bees in pollination.
2. Set up "flowers" around the room with some containing "pollen" (flour or colored powder).
3. Give each child a cotton swab and have them act as bees, collecting and transferring pollen between flowers.
4. Explain how this helps plants grow food for us to eat.

Supplies

1. Small cups (representing flowers)
2. Cotton swabs or pom-poms (representing pollen)
3. Yellow construction paper wings or headbands (optional for fun)
