

Bee Pollination Activity

Have a pollination relay and learn how bees transfer pollen from one flower to another

Directions

- Read the book and discuss the role of bees in pollination.
- 2.Set up "flowers" around the room with some containing "pollen" (flour or colored powder).
- 3. Give each child a cotton swab and have them act as bees, collecting and transferring pollen between flowers.
- 4. Explain how this helps plants grow food for us to eat.

Supplies

- Small cups (representing flowers)
- 2. Cotton swabs or pom-poms (representing pollen)
- Yellow construction paper wings or headbands (optional for fun)
