



Cropland Collage

Children will determine the variety of crops that grow in the area they live in. Discuss what crops look like through the seasons of growth.

Directions

1. Provide each child with a template.
2. Children should rip and cut paper scraps and glue them to the template to form the hills of cropland. Different crops can be grown on each hill.
3. Use tactile pieces such as buttons, grains, or cotton to form the clouds, sun, and blooms or fruits of each crop.
4. Remember the template is a guide.
5. Ask children to explain what it is like growing up on a farm.

Supplies

- Scissors
 - Glue
 - Paper scraps (construction, newspapers, wallpaper, tissue, be creative)
 - Cotton
 - Small beads, seeds, grains, buttons, or other tactile items
- Cropland template
