



2026 NAITC Conference Scholarships

This year's National Agriculture in the Classroom conference will be held June 22-25 in Providence, Rhode Island. This is an opportunity for educators from across the country to come together to not only experience agriculture within the host state, but to learn more about how to integrate agriculture into the core curriculum of their classroom.

Funds are available to offer scholarships to pre-kindergarten-12th grade teachers to attend the 2026 National Agriculture in the Classroom Conference through the generosity of the following sponsors:





This year's scholarships (valued at \$1300) will provide:

- 1- Early Bird Registration (\$525)
- Up to 3 nights lodging at conference location (Omni Providence)

Scholarship Qualifications:

- State-certified classroom teacher, currently employed by a public or private school
- PreK-12th grade teacher who wishes to use agricultural concepts to teach core subject areas to enhance students' understanding of agriculture*
- Plan to teach during 2026-2027 school year

*Secondary Agriculture Education teachers are not eligible for these scholarships, however we encourage you to apply <u>HERE</u> for a White-Reinhardt Scholarship.

The 2026 NAITC Conference Scholarship applications are now open. The application deadline is December 15, 2025. Applicants will be notified by early February to enable them to register and secure the early-bird registration cost of \$525 provided by the scholarship.
