

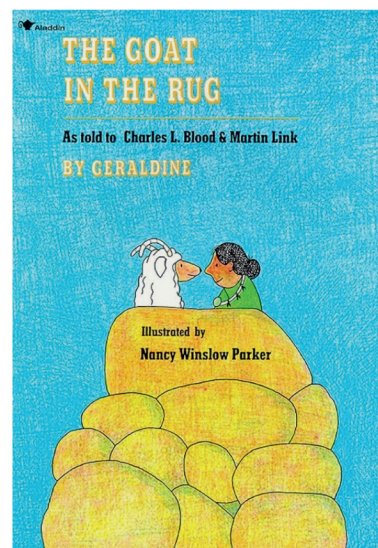
“The Goat in the Rug” Natural Resource Bracelet

Each bead represents a necessary component in making mohair (hair of the angora goat) that can be used in the making of such things as blankets, rugs, warm weather clothing, etc.

Use yarn (8-10 inches in length) and one bead of each of the following colors (red, white, green, brown, yellow, blue, and clear) to create a bracelet that reminds you of what’s needed to help the angora goats, like Geraldine, to produce good quality fiber.

Activity 2: Natural Resource Bracelet

- Red:** **Farmer/Rancher** — Watch health/wellness of the herd
- White:** **Goat** — Angora (breed used for mohair/fiber production)
- Green:** **Food** — The great “recyclers” - forage, grass, brush, weeds
- Brown:** **Soil** — Healthy soil to help plants for the goats to eat
- Yellow:** **Sun** — Photosynthesis provides energy for the plants to grow
- Blue:** **Water** — Goats and plants need water to live
- Clear:** **Air** — Goats need to breathe and so do plants
