**1852 -** The first cow was imported to the U.S. & purchased by Winthrop Chenery who then formed the foundation herd of the breed in 1861.

**1885 -** The present Holstein-Friesian Association of America was officially incorporated with 284 members.

1994 - The Holstein-Fresian Association officially changed its name to Holstein Association USA, Inc.

**Today -** There are about 20,000 adult members & 8,000 junior members in the Holstein Association.

Holsteins are the most popular breed of dairy cattle because they surpass all breeds in total pounds of milk and milk components produced.
