



## PK-2ND GRADE COLORING CONTEST RULES:

## Postmark Deadline: January 5, 2024

- Students who are currently in Pre-K through 2nd grade may submit coloring sheets.
- Contest entries must be completed on the coloring sheet template included with these rules. Media may include markers, crayons, colored pencils, watercolor, ink, acrylic, or tempera paint. No pastels or chalk media will be accepted.
- ❖ The 2024 theme is "Agriculture Is Everywhere"
- The coloring sheet template should be copied front and back so that the student's information is filled out on the back of the coloring sheet.
- **Submit all entries for state judging.**

- Please make sure all student names are spelled correctly when typing them in the form, as the spelling you submit will be used to create certificates.
