

9th-12th GRADE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST RULES:

Postmark Deadline: January 6, 2024

- Students who are currently in 9th-12th grade may submit a contest entry. Submit all entries for state judging.
- ❖ The 2024 theme is "**Aggie & Annie Discover Agriculture!**".
- A copy of the official entry form must be legibly completed and securely attached to the back of each entry. (1 page attached includes 4 copies of official entry form). Please also include a signed Copyright release for each student. We will need to make copies of winning photographs.
- **♦** Entry must contain at least one (1), but not more than three (3), 5"x7" color prints that were taken by the student. Photos MUST BE attached to either 8 ½"x11" or 11"x17" paper in landscape orientation. NO OTHER SIZES WILL BE JUDGED. Photos must be on paper that will allow for duplication, framing, and display cardstock or a half-poster board is preferred. Posters must be sent in FLAT; NOT folded, matted, mounted, laminated, or framed.
- NEW RULE: In order to achieve the theme, please include a colored cut out of Flat Aggie AND/OR Annie in your photo(s). They are in the attached documents. We may request a digital version of your photo to be used on the Flat Aggie and Annie Instagram account.
- Copyright laws prohibit the use of any picture other than one the student has taken his or herself. Pictures on newsprint or those that have been mechanically altered will not be accepted.
- The phrase, "Aggie & Annie Discover Agriculture!" must be included on the title of the poster.
- A caption, of no more than 20 words may be added under each photo.
- theme, photo quality, and composition.

- Please make sure all student names are spelled correctly on entry form as the spelling you submit will be used to create certificates.
- ❖ A panel of judges will decide the winning entries.
