

## **3rd-12th GRADE POSTER CONTEST RULES:**

## Postmark Deadline: January 6, 2025

- Students who are currently in **3rd-12th grade** may submit posters. **Submit all entries for state judging**.
- Media may include markers, crayons, colored pencils, watercolor, ink, acrylic, or tempera paint. No pastels or chalk media will be accepted.
- The **<u>phrase</u>**, "**Aggie & Annie Discover Agriculture**!" <u>**must**</u> be included in the design of the poster.
- Posters MUST BE either 8 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"x11" or 11"x14" in landscape orientation. NO OTHER SIZES WILL BE JUDGED.
- A copy <u>of the official entry form must be legibly completed and securely attached to the back of each entry</u>. (1 page attached includes 4 copies of official entry form)
- Posters must be on paper that will allow for duplication, framing, and display. Posters may be flat **OR** rolled; **NOT** folded, matted, mounted, laminated, or framed.
- Copyright laws prohibit the use of cartoon characters or TV figures.

This year you will NOT mail or email your class list to us; you will need to enter student names and only mail the posters. Thank you!!
- Please make sure all student names are spelled correctly on the entry form as the spelling you submit will be used to create certificates.
- A panel of judges will decide the winning entries.

- One Overall Winner will be selected for Elementary (3rd-5th grade); Middle School (6th-8th grade); and High School (9th-12th grade). Each one will receive a \$50 cash award, citations from legislators, and plaque.
- 1st place poster finalists will be chosen from EACH grade level and will receive a \$20 cash prize, citations from legislators, and a medal.
- 2nd and 3rd place poster finalists will be chosen from EACH grade level and will receive a \$10 cash prize, citations from legislators, and a medal.
- Awards will be presented in 2025. Date and Location TBD
- Each contest participant will receive a personalized certificate.
- Winning coloring sheets will be featured on our website.
