EARLY CHILDHOOD

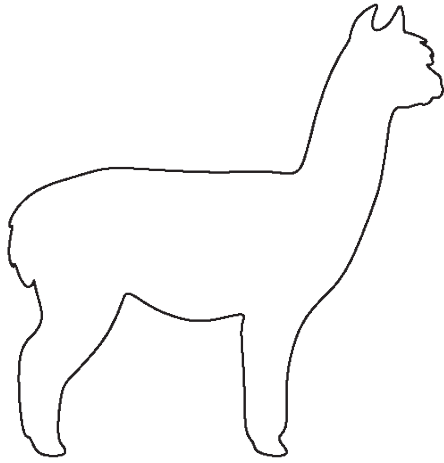
Alpacas live on a farm. They have soft hair called fleece. It can be used to make clothes for people. The fleece can be 22 different colors. The main colors are white, brown, gray, and black.

There are two kinds of alpacas. One kind is the Huacaya (wah-KI-ah). They have a fleece which is short and wavy. The other kind is the Suri (SUR-ee). They have a long, wavy fleece.

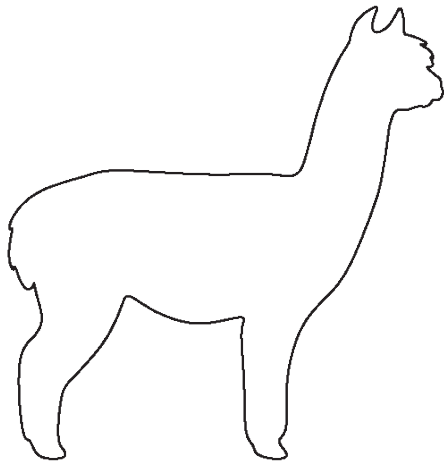
The farmer cuts the alpaca's fleece in the spring. This is called shearing. The fleece is spun into yarn. The yarn is used to make socks or blankets.



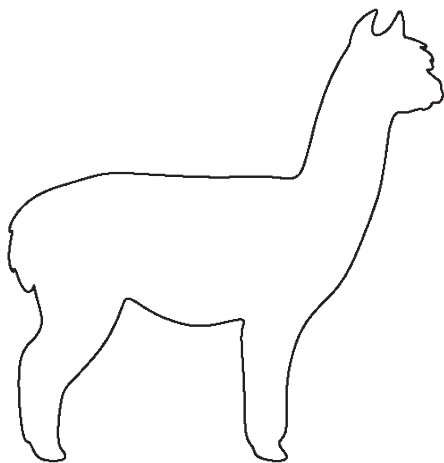

Alpaca fleece is so soft. Kings and queens have used it in their royal robes.

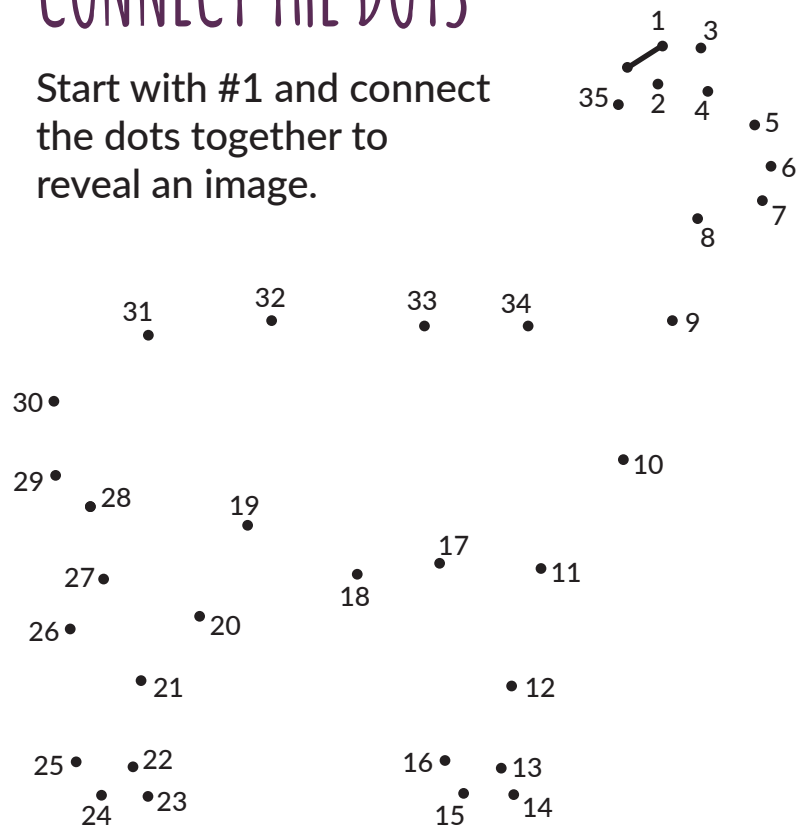
Alpacas live 15-20 years.
