


CHICKENS EARLY CHILDHOOD

Chickens are birds raised for meat and eggs. Chickens live together in flocks. Adult female chickens are hens. Adult male chickens are roosters. Baby chickens are chicks. Chicken eggs hatch in about 21 days.

Chickens like to scratch at the soil to look for seeds and insects. They also eat feed made of grain.

Some hens can lay over 300 eggs per year.

EASY EGG SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

- 8 large eggs
- 1 large dill pickle
- 2 teaspoons dill pickle juice
- 2 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 3 teaspoons yellow mustard
- 2 teaspoons white sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/8 teaspoon black pepper

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Boil the eggs and then let them cool.
- 2. When eggs are cool to the touch, peel, and dice.
- 3. Whisk together all other ingredients in a large bowl. Gently fold in eggs.
- 4. Serve as a side or in rolls.
