

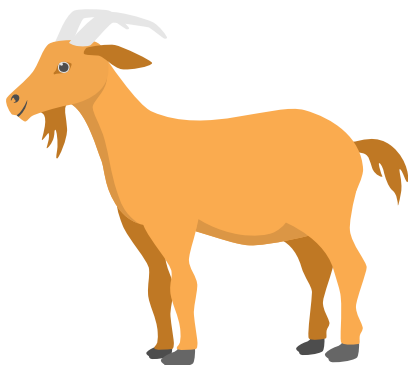


GOAT

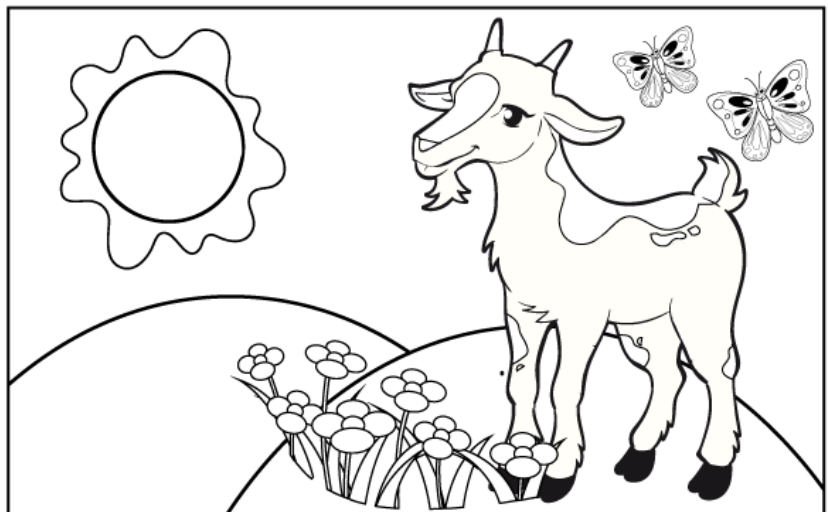
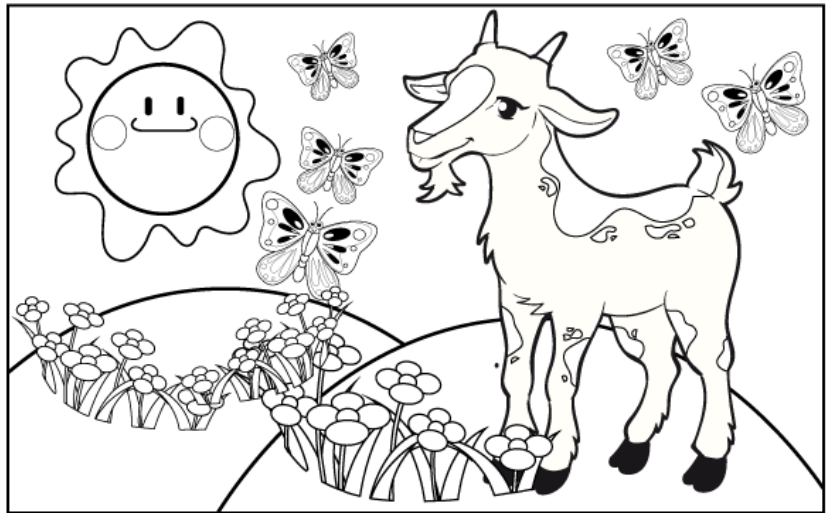
