Facts About Bovine

Milk was named Oklahoma's official state beverage in **2002**.



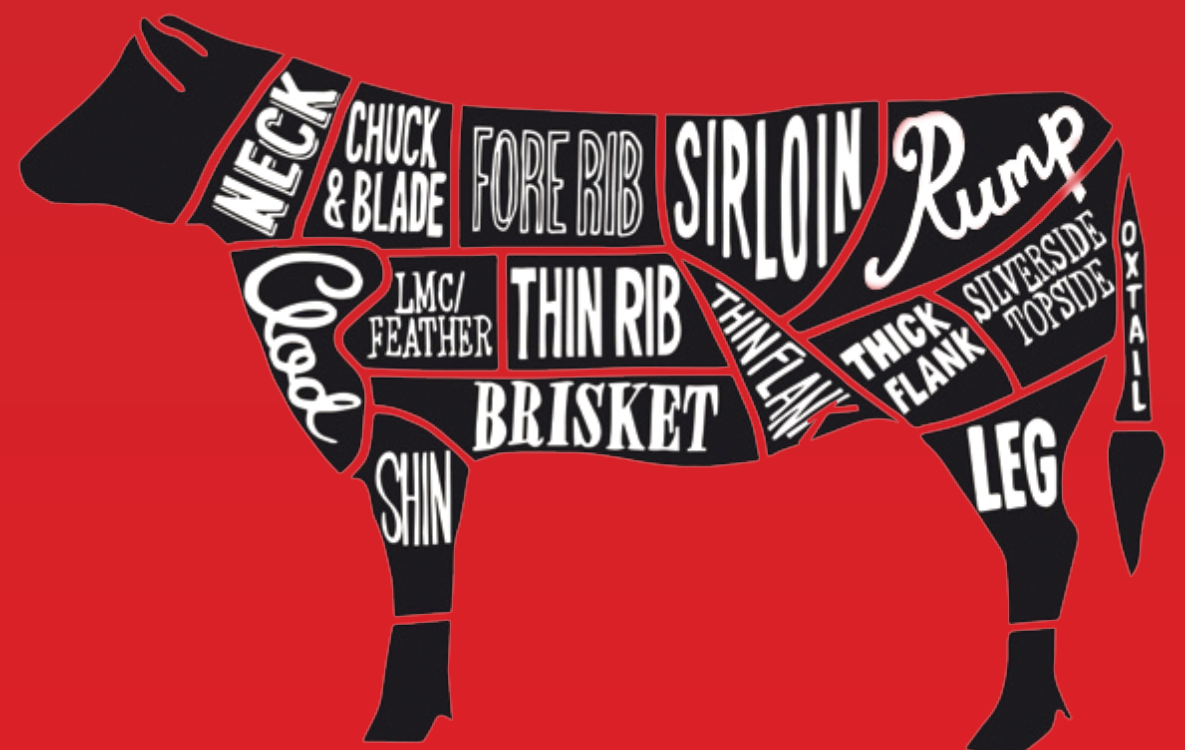
Bovine is the scientific name for beef or dairy cattle.



Each year Americans consume **25** billion hamburgers.



Cattle move their jaws about **40,000** times a day, chewing cud or grass about **40** times a minute.



A **1,000** pound steer will provide about **430** pounds of edible meat.



Holstein cows produce the most milk.

An average dairy cow will produce **6.8** gallons of milk per day. That's more than **2,476** gallons a year.



The beef industry generates more income than any other agricultural enterprise in our state. In 2016, Oklahoma's cattle and calf population was **4.85** million.
