types of resins isolated from canola are used in the manufacturing of ink that is used for printing newspapers.



Canola produces small yellow flowers that are a rich source of nectar which attracts bees.

pounds of canola seed for the extraction of 10 liters of oil. Canola oil is used for cooking and as an ingredient in salad dressing.



Wheat is the #1 crop grown in Oklahoma. Most of the wheat grown here is hard red winter wheat.





Fruit of canola is a pod. It looks like a pea pod, but it is 5 times smaller. A pod contains 20, black or brown round seeds.

A kernel is a wheat seed. There are 1,000,000 kernels in a bushel.





It takes  $\frac{9}{2}$  seconds for a combine to harvest enough wheat to make about  $\frac{70}{2}$  loaves of bread.  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre will produce enough wheat for about  $\frac{2}{500}$  loaves of wheat bread.
