## It's a Bird, It's a Mammal, It's a Farm Animal!



**Chickens** are birds. They have feathers. Their babies hatch from eggs. Chickens do not make milk for their **chicks**.



Horses are mammals, too. Did you know horses have milk? Their babies drink it. A baby horse is a foal.



**Pigs** also have hair. They have a litter of **piglets**, not just one baby. They make milk for the piglets to drink. They are mammals, too.



**Sheep** are mammals. They have milk, hair, and wool. Their babies are born alive. They are called **lambs**.

Turkeys are birds. They have feathers, like a chicken. A baby turkey hatches from an egg. It is called a **poult**. Turkeys do not drink milk.





**Cows** make milk for their calves to drink. A cow and a calf have hair. The **calf** is born alive. Cows and calves are also mammals.
