

BEES AND HONEY



Honey bees are insects. They need each other to live. Bees live in groups. These groups are called colonies.

Bees make honey from nectar. Nectar is a sweet liquid. It is found inside flower blossoms. Worker bees collect the nectar. They carry it to the colony. Bees have pouches in their body to carry the nectar. These pouches are called the honey sac.

Honey bees are the only insects who make food eaten by humans. Honey is the only food which does not spoil.



Honey bees do a "waggle dance." The dance tells other bees where to find food.

Honey Peanut Butter Cheerio Bars

- 1/2 cup honey
- 3/4 cup peanut butter
- 3 cups Cheerios



Line 8"x8" pan with aluminum foil and set aside. Cook honey and peanut butter over medium heat, stirring until completely melted and blended. Remove from heat and stir in cereal. Mix until evenly coated. Place mixture in prepared pan and press in place. Refrigerate for 1 hour before cutting into bars. Cut into preferred size and enjoy!

What shape makes up the comb? Circle the correct answer. Then color the comb yellow.

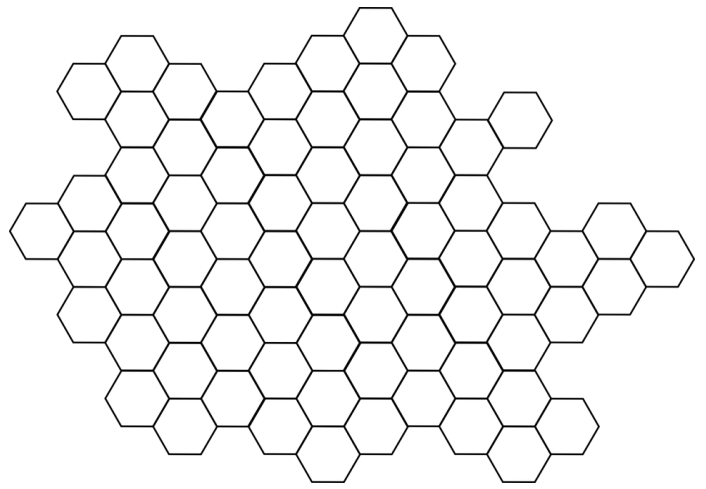
Square
