Cotton Boll Angels

Materials:

1/2 or 3/4 wooden bead- for the head Cotton boll- for the body Small tinsel for halo Small ribbon for hanging and for bow Hot glue gun

Directions:

Cut the stem off of a cotton boll.



Tie a knot in the ribbon you will use for hanging your angel and thread the ribbon through the bead. Trim off any extra ribbon from the bottom.

Hot glue the bottom of the head to the cotton boll where the stem was.

Make a small halo with the tinsel and attach to top of head with hot glue.

Hot glue a small ribbon bow to the front of your angel.

Optional:

Hot glue wings on from broken burrs.
