



Seed Sam

Explore plant needs and seed germination by making a Seed Sam!

Directions

1. Review the conditions necessary for a seed to germinate, or sprout. All plants need water, sunlight, space, and nutrients to grow into healthy plants.
2. Allow students to decorate their cups with faces using markers, stickers, or other available craft supplies.
3. Fill each cup with potting soil.
4. Plant several seeds at the top of the cup and moisten soil.
5. Place cups in a warm location, preferably near a window.
6. Water as needed and watch your Seed Sam grow!
7. After several weeks you may harvest and give your Seed Sam a haircut.

Supplies

- Clear plastic cups
- Seeds (suggested types include grass seed or herbs such as parsley, chives, or basil)
- Potting soil
- Water
- Craft supplies such as stickers or markers
