

Irresistible Ice Cream

Recognize the milk in ice cream comes from dairy cows. Dairy products are full of vitamins which help maintain bone strength.

Directions

- 1. Explain this activity to ensure each step is done with you. Each student should have the large and small sized baggies and ingredients within groups prior to beginning.
- 2. Fill the large bag full of ice and add 6 tablespoons of rock salt. Seal the bag.
- 3. Put a ½ cup of milk, ¼ teaspoon of vanilla, and 1 tablespoon of sugar into the small bag and seal it.
- 4. Place the small bag inside the large one and seal it again carefully.
- 5. Shake the bag until the mixture is ice cream, which takes about 5 minutes. (This will be very cold so you may want to have children use paper towels to hold the bags.)
- 6. Wipe off the top of the bag, open, and enjoy!

Supplies

- Gallon sized baggies
- Pint sized baggies
- Ice
- Vanilla Sugar
- Milk
- Rock salt
- Spoons
- Napkins
- All ingredients should be enough for each student to use
