



## **Water Cycle Bracelet**

Identify the stages of the water cycle - evaporation, condensation, and precipitation.

## **Directions**

- 1. Discuss with children the importance of the water cycle to grow plants, provide water for animals, and provide us with lakes and streams.
- 2. Have children create the water cycle bracelet by stringing beads on a pipe cleaner in the following order:
- Yellow represents the sun which heats the Earth.
- Clear- represents evaporation when water turns to vapor and rises into the sky.
- White- represents condensation as the water vapor joins with dust to form clouds.
- Blue- represents precipitation as water falls back to the Earth as rain, sleet, or snow.
- 3. Share *The Water Cycle Song!* (To the tune of She'll Be Comin' 'Round the Mountain)
