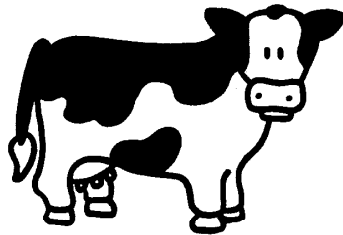
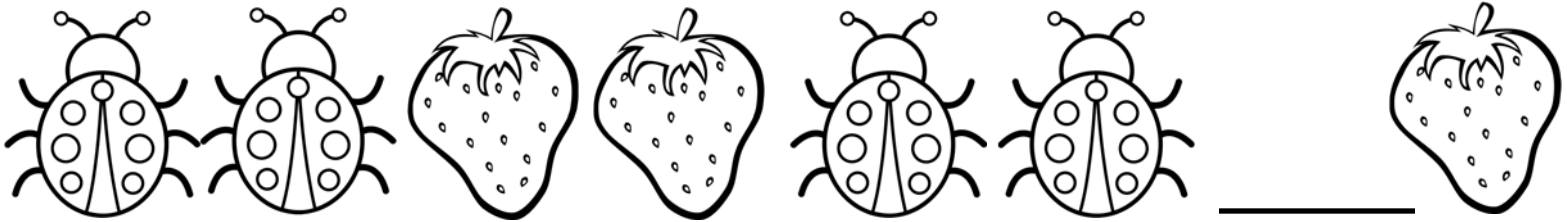
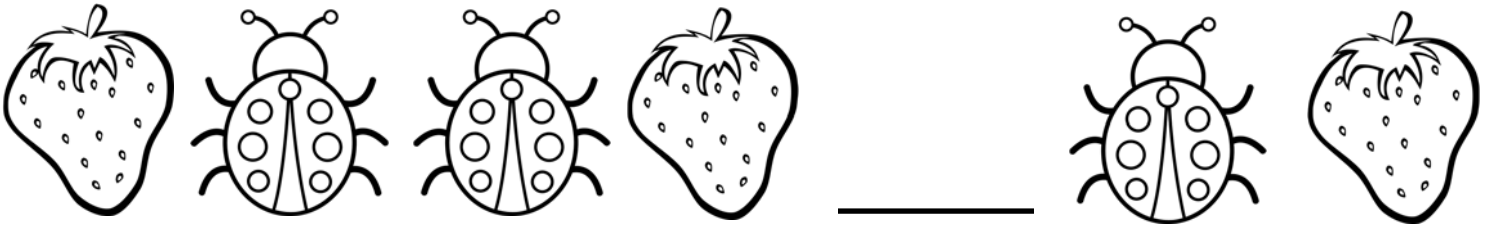


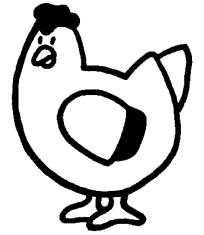
# Spring on the Farm

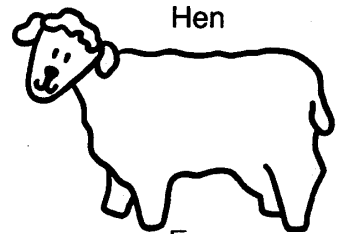

Match the mother to her baby by drawing a line connecting the two.

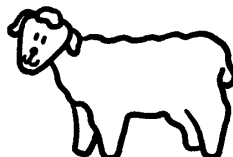
