FARM TO TABLE

How does milk move from cow to the store and get processed into delicious products, such as ice cream and cheese?



Dairy cows make milk. Dairy products, like cheese and ice cream, are made from the milk from dairy cows that live on Wisconsin dairy farms.



Cows need to be milked 2-3 times a day on the farm.

The milk is then loaded into a refrigerated truck and travels to a milk processing factory.



After the dairy product is made, it is shipped to grocery stores and restaurants where consumers can buy it.



At the factory, the milk is processed into dairy products like cheese, milk and ice cream.



Milk can be made into products for us to enjoy!
