

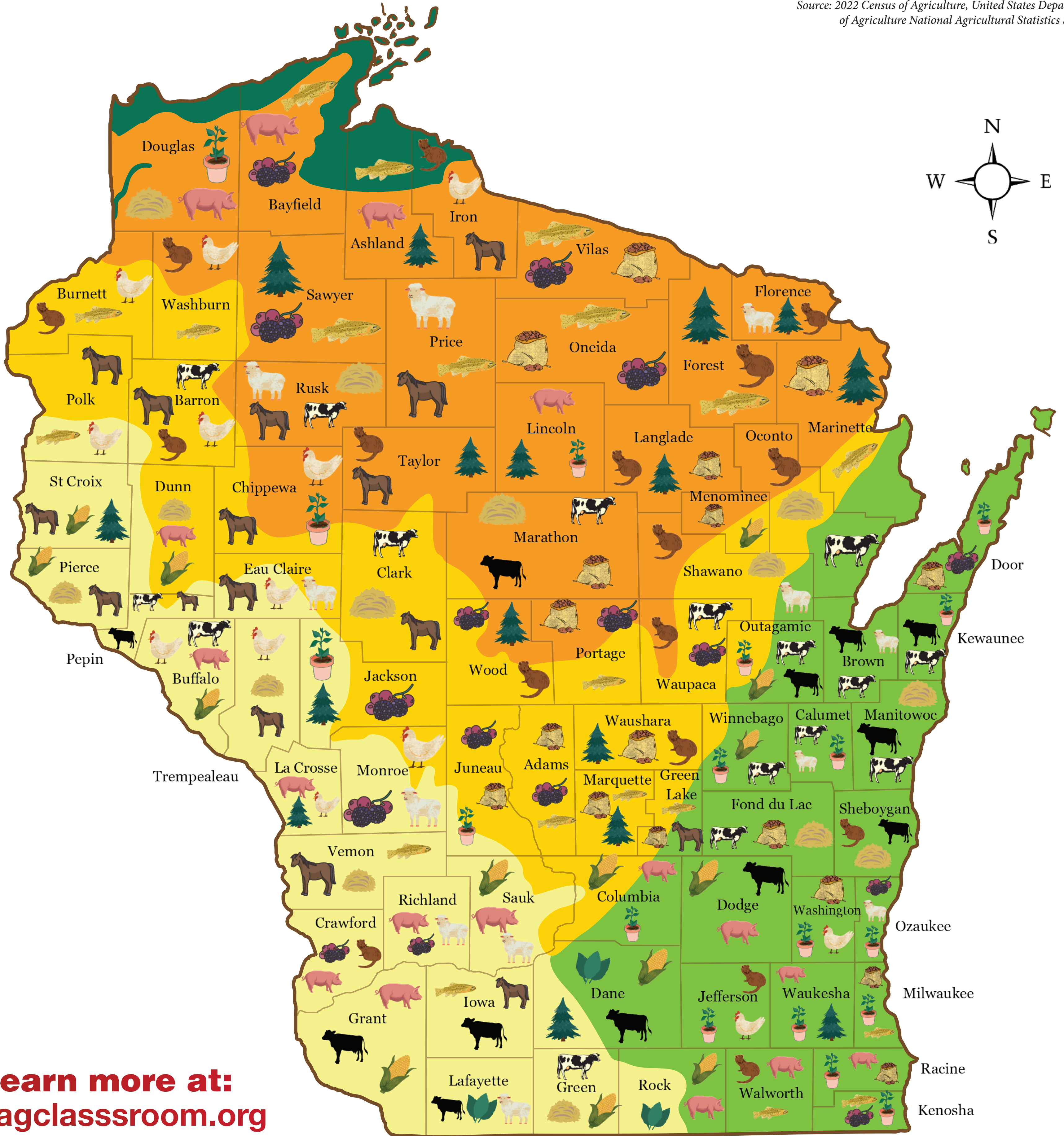
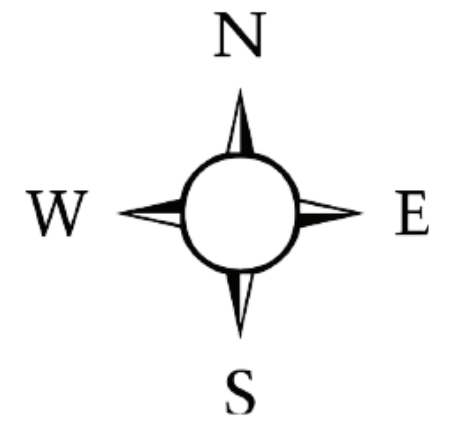


# Agriculture Across Wisconsin
